

Online CDA Scholarships Available!



through Atlantic Cape Community College

Scholarship funds have been made available for regulated child care and education programs or registered family child care providers receiving state-funded subsidies (through the Child Care Resource & Referral Agencies). The Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential must be obtained online through Atlantic Cape Community College. Full scholarships will be provided for remedial coursework, mandatory fees and assessments and/or tests. Scholarship recipients will be supported by a mentor.

Am I Eligible?

- You must be an active member of the NJ Registry for Childhood Professionals and remain active while on scholarship.
- You must be an assistant teacher, teacher, or registered family child care provider in a child care or education program serving low-income children receiving child care subsidies and not in receipt of any other Department of Human Services/Division of Family Development funded scholarships for education.
